What year am I?

1st year: By age, you're a 10th or 11th grader. Either you are new to WTMC this year or you completed 9th grade at WTMC last year. You're probably taking 4 Middle College classes now.

2nd year: By age, you're an 11th or 12th grader. Last year, you were in the "1st year" situation described above.

3rd year: By age, you're a 12th grader or older. You're probably graduating this year.

PSAT:

1st Year and 2nd Year students are required to take the PSAT provided by WTMC on October 24th, 2018. Additional information will be mailed to each student during the first week of October. Taking the PSAT is a great opportunity to take a standardized test and 2nd Year students may qualify for a National Merit Scholarship.

Parent Orientations:

Parents of 9th Grade students and 1st Year students are encouraged to attend the Parent Open House. This is a great opportunity to learn more about the program, expectations, and future meetings. The 9th Grade student meeting will be held on Oct. 9th. This meeting is from 6:00pm to 8:00pm at ML 101. The 1st Year student meeting will be held on Oct. 16th. This meeting is from 6:00pm to 8:00pm at ML 101.

EDP and Credit Reviews:

All students graduating in December 2018 or May/July 2019 will need to meet with Mr. Cockels by Nov. 9th for a graduation credit review. All second years graduating in May/ July 2020 must meet with Ms. Riley for an EDP Review by Nov. 9th. Appointments for a Credit Review and EDP Review can be made through Mrs. Williams at the front desk in the WTMC office (TI 224). Do not schedule your appointments at the last minute! Doing so will prevent you from registering for Winter semester classes!

Military Parents:

As part of a new federal initiative WTMC is required to ask each student if they have a parent who is active duty in the Armed Forces.
