PSAT

1st Year and 2nd Year students are required to take the PSAT provided by WTMC on October 25th, 2017. Additional information will be mailed to each student during the first week of October. Taking the PSAT is a great opportunity to take a standardized test and 2nd Year students may qualify for a National Merit Scholarship.
